FERSTER: That, Bylaw No. 2024-06 A Bylaw of The RM of Shellbrook No. 493 To Amend Bylaw No. 08-1981 Known as The Zoning Bylaw as annexed hereto and forming a part of these minutes, be given first reading incorporating revisions to:

- Change the maximum density in 3.3.2(3) from 32 to 16 sites per quarter section within the CR Zoning District.
- 0 Change the minimum site area requirement for dwelling types listed in 3.3.1(1)(a) and (b) from 0.8 ha to 4.05 ha, and include a mechanism for a lesser site size where it is an established yard site or where natural physical circumstances make a 4.05 ha site unachievable.
- o Increase the maximum floor area for detached accessory buildings in the CR District listed in 3.3.1(4)(a) from 150m2 to a combined maximum of all detached accessory buildings of 464.5 m2 (5000 ft2) on a site.
- o Introduce appropriate definitions for Home Based Businesses and Ancillary Use
